



2020 Wyoming State Fair Youth Horse Show Policies as of 8/1/2020:

1. A processing fee of \$15.00 per head per division is to be paid at the time the entry is made.
2. Animal Health requirements refer to page 54 for Equine requirements.
3. Youth exhibitors pay no stall charges. Stalls will be available Sunday at 9 AM.
4. Stall registration and assignments will be made upon arrival at the stall building at the south end of the PEPSI equine center. To be stalled together, you must arrive together. Exhibitors who do not clean their stalls at the end of the show will be subject to a stall cleaning charge of \$20. Stalls are to be vacated by the end of the show on Tuesday (unless prior arrangements have been made in writing and confirmed with the stalling office.) Failure to clean stalls will result in forfeiture of premium earnings.
5. Stall office hours will be posted.
6. Youth show exhibitors are to check in with the horse show office for the horse show, at the north end of PEPSI center. Numbers and patterns are available at the horse show office.
7. Youth show exhibitors showing other species of livestock are permitted to bring their other exhibits onto the grounds at the time of the youth horse show.
8. No exhibitor may enter more than one horse in any class that may require rail work.
9. The top two placing 4-H members from each county and the top two placing FFA members from each chapter at the most recent county competition are the eligible entrants. Dropping down in the placing of entrants to fill specific class entries will be allowed. Halter horses need not have placed first at the county level but must be of halter quality and must have been shown by the exhibitor at the county level.

10. Mixed teams (4H & FFA) will be allowed in the Team Roping, provided that the team was entered properly in advance. Each team must enter as a team, and each team member must be from the same county.
11. Mixed teams (4H&FFA) may also enter ranch sorting. They must enter as a team and be from the same county.
12. ALL entrants in Stock events MUST pay stock charge at time of entry.
13. Stock Charges per exhibitor \$10 Goat tying & breakaway roping. \$5 per exhibitor team roping. \$35 working cow horse, \$17.50 ranch sorting.
14. All 4-H and FFA equines entered must be the same as recorded by the 4-H or FFA member in his/her project.
15. NO STALLIONS are allowed in the Youth Horse Show.
16. Safe horsemanship guidelines must be followed at all times during the Youth Horse Show to protect exhibitors and spectators. Unsafe practices will be prohibited (i.e. Riding double, riding bareback, riding with halters, riding at a speed greater than a walk outside of an arena). All animals must be under control at all times during the youth show. Unruly animals may be excused.
17. The State Fair Youth Horse Show will use the Wyoming 4-H Equine Competition guidelines which can be found online at www.edu/4h/projects/horse.
18. In the event that 4H Guidelines are not clear, the AQHA rulebook will be used to determine appropriate course of action. The judge's interpretation of any rule or guideline is final.
19. Programmed Ride will use the United States Equestrian Team Federation 2019 Training Level Test 1 for Juniors Test 2 for Intermediates, Seniors will ride Test 3
20. Judges will provide patterns. Patterns will be posted and Copies provided the morning of the show.
21. The member and parent code of conduct will be observed and enforced.
